Eligibility for Scholarship:

In order to apply you will need to demonstrate that:

- You have successfully been awarded a 1st Class Honours degree from a UK or EU institution
- You must be studying a full-time 180-credit Masters (taught) course at University of Bolton. PGCE/Cert Ed courses and masters courses that qualify for undergraduate SFE funding are not eligible courses for this award
- You must not be in receipt of any other award from the university
- You must not be in receipt of any other kind of sponsorship towards your tuition fees for example from an employer

- The course of study must have commenced in September 2021 or January 2022

Please note that even though you may fulfil the eligibility for the award this does not guarantee you will receive one due to the restricted number of awards available.

Guidance notes:

The amount of the award is a full tuition fee waiver. There will be a maximum of four awards made in the 2021/22 academic year and applications will be considered in strict date order of receipt.

Students must be willing to represent the University as an ambassador and be involved in marketing activity of the University of Bolton, which could be in the form of Blogs, Vlogs, testimonials, quotes, talks, interviews etc.
