# University of Bolton Teaching Intensive, Research Informed

### **Alumni Postgraduate Bursary 2020**

The *Alumni Postgraduate Bursary 2020* is designed to reward those students who successfully graduated from the University of Bolton in the summer of 2020 and progress directly onto a Master's degree or PhD at the University in September 2020.

### **Amount**

This bursary will be awarded as a £1,000 top up on your #UniAsItShouldBe card and a £500 payment directly to you, providing a total award of £1,500.

## Eligibility

- 1. This award is available to all Home/EU and International students graduating from courses 'On-Campus' and those students graduating from 'Off-Campus' franchise partners where you are fully registered as a student at the University of Bolton.
- 2. This award is available for full and part-time 180 credit Master's degrees. It is not available for any partial Master's courses or any other postgraduate courses including PGCE or Cert Ed courses. Please see terms and conditions for excluded courses.
- 3. The award is also available to Undergraduate or Master's graduates progressing to a PhD at the University of Bolton to be paid in the first year of study only.
- 4. The Master's/PhD course must be studied On-Campus at the University of Bolton and not at a franchise partner location.
- 5. This award is available only for Master's/PhD courses commencing in September 2020 and no other intakes.
- 6. Graduates must meet the normal entry requirements for the programme including the usual pre-requisite degree course.

### **Payment**

This award will be paid as a £1,000 addition to qualifying students' #UniAsItShouldBe card and a £500 BACs award paid direct into the students' bank account subject to continuing eligibility.

This award will be paid in three instalments:

- The first payment of £500 paid on to the #UniAsItShouldBe card will be made once enrolment is completed
- The second payment of £500 paid on to the #UniAsItShouldBe card will be paid upon successfully paying 1/3 of the tuition fees to the University
- The third instalment of £500 paid via BACs will be awarded upon successfully paying 1/3 of the tuition fees to the University.

  payable for any outstanding modules not completed
- It is possible for a student to have paid one third of their tuition fees and still remain in arrears. If these circumstances arise the full £500 BACs payment will be offset against the remaining tuition fee balance
- Students in receipt of this bursary will not be eligible for any other scholarship, bursary or award from the University whilst studying the Master's/PhD course
- This award is NOT available in conjunction with the Alumni Loyalty Discount
- The following courses are excluded from the scheme:
